MATCH THE DESCRIPTION WITH THE IMAGE

a. - 3

Daguerreotype: an image on a highly polished surface of silver, coated onto a copper plate. It is usually protected in a case with a decorative mask and a glass cover. When held at a correct angle to the light a positive, sharp, and detailed image is visible. At other angles a negative or the silver mirror finish is seen.

b. - 2

Ambrotype: a glass negative with a black backing that makes the image appear as a positive. Like the daguerreotype it is usually cased and is easily differentiated from the daguerreotype by the lack of any mirror finish.

c. - 6

Cyanotype: Popular for proofing negatives, usually blue. Principle use was for copying architectural drawings, hence the name "blueprint."

d. - 5

Tintype: a positive image produced on a piece of thin blackened metal.

e. - 1

Carte de visite (cdv): card mounted photograph, typically 2.5 x 4 inches (63 x 100 mm).

f. - 4

Cabinet card: card mounted photograph, typically 4.25 x 6.5 inches (108 x 164 mm).

g. - 7

Stereo card: pair of identical looking photographic prints mounted next to each other on a card, usually about 3.5 x 7 inches.
